



## **NOTICE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND STAKEHOLDERS**

### **CALL OUT FOR CANDIDATES TO SIT FOR THE HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL OF ZAMBIA (HPCZ) LICENSURE EXAMINATION (LEX) SEPTEMBER 2018**

The Health Professions Council of Zambia (HPCZ) is a statutory body that was established by the Health Professions Act No. 24 of 2009. The Act renames and continues the existence of the Medical Council of Zambia established by the Medical and Allied Professions Act of 1977.

The Health Professions Act No. 24 of 2009 provides for the registration of health practitioners and regulation of their professional conduct; provides for the licensing of health facilities and the accreditation of health care services provided by health facilities; and provides for the recognition and approval of training programmes for health practitioners.

In the exercise of its functions under this Act, the Health Professions Council of Zambia is now calling all candidates eligible to sit for the HPCZ Licensure Examination (LEX) to apply.

The prospective candidate (s) shall meet the following conditions:

- 1. MUST be eligible to sit for the HPCZ Licensure Examination (LEX) in September 2018.**
- 2. MUST make payment of Registration / Application Forms fee through ZANACO Bank using Bill Master Form as follows:**  
Diploma and Certificate Holders: K 800 (Zambian nationals), K 1, 600 or its equivalent (Foreign nationals)  
Degree holders – K 1,000 (Zambian nationals), K2, 000 or its equivalent (Foreign nationals)

3. MUST select and indicate their preferred Examination Centre to sit from (Either Lusaka or Ndola). The exact Venues will be communicated later.

4. MUST complete their registration within the Registration period running from: Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> to Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018 at 17.00 hours.

4. Requirements for Registration SHALL include the following:

- a. Copy of National Registration Card (NRC) or Passport for Non-Zambians,
  - b. HPCZ Student Indexing Number,
  - c. Certified copy of the Degree, Diploma, Certificate or Final results transcript from Training Institution offering HPCZ recognized programme,
  - d. Zambia Qualifications Authority (ZAQA) recognition certificate (Graduates of foreign Training Institutions)
  - e. ZANACO Bank deposit slip.
5. Application fees MUST be deposited at ZANACO Bank using Bill Master Form (Proof of Payment (receipts)).

Kindly note that: NO application (s) will be considered after Tuesday, 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018, 17.00 hours.
